**MISTRIAL (HUNG JURY) ORDER**

On May 22, 2023, the above styled and numbered cause was called to trial. An Assistant District Attorney of Harris County represented the State of Texas.

The Defendant appeared (select one)

- Pro se.
- With counsel.

Both parties announced ready for trial. A jury was selected and empanelled. Defendant was arraigned and entered a plea of not guilty.

The jury heard 16 hours 29 minutes of evidence and deliberated 12 hours 7 minutes. The jury reports that it is hopelessly deadlocked and it would be useless to continue deliberations. The court finds 1) it is improbable the jury can reach a verdict and 2) keeping the jury together any longer will not result in a verdict.

**Accordingly, this Court declares a mistrial and orders the jury, if any, discharged.**
