In this draft deal, Iran gets a lot of big benefits now. The U.S. gets less for now and is hoping a future deal gives more.



- Huge money for Iran (at least \$300 billion)
- Oil can be sold again
- Sanctions (U.S. and UN) end
- Frozen money becomes available
- Iran keeps its current nuclear program (for now)
- U.S. promises not to attack and will pull troops out

Bottom line:

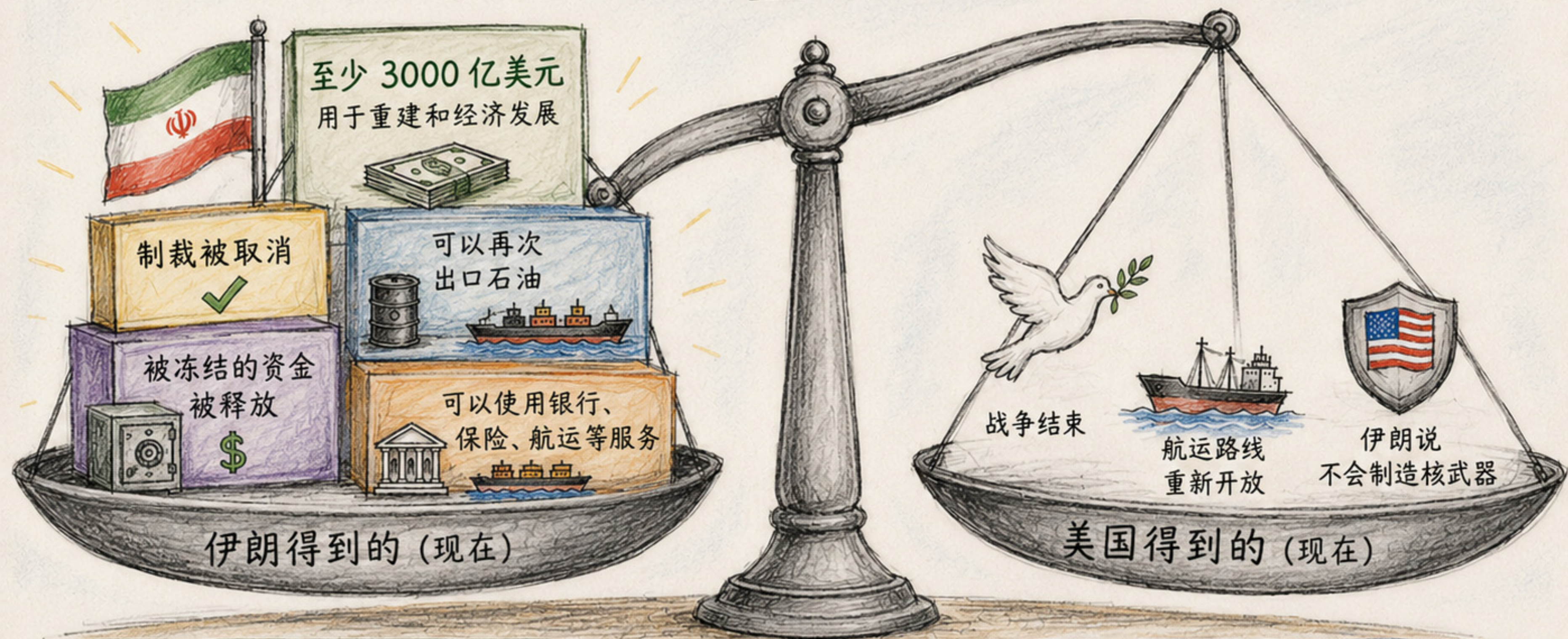
Iran gets big economic benefits now.

The U.S. is betting that a future agreement will get stronger limits on Iran's nuclear program.

- War ends
- Ships can travel freely again
- Iran says it won't build nuclear weapons
- Nuclear issues and other big concerns are delayed for later negotiations

➔ The U.S. hopes the **FINAL AGREEMENT** will get stronger nuclear limits and more controls.

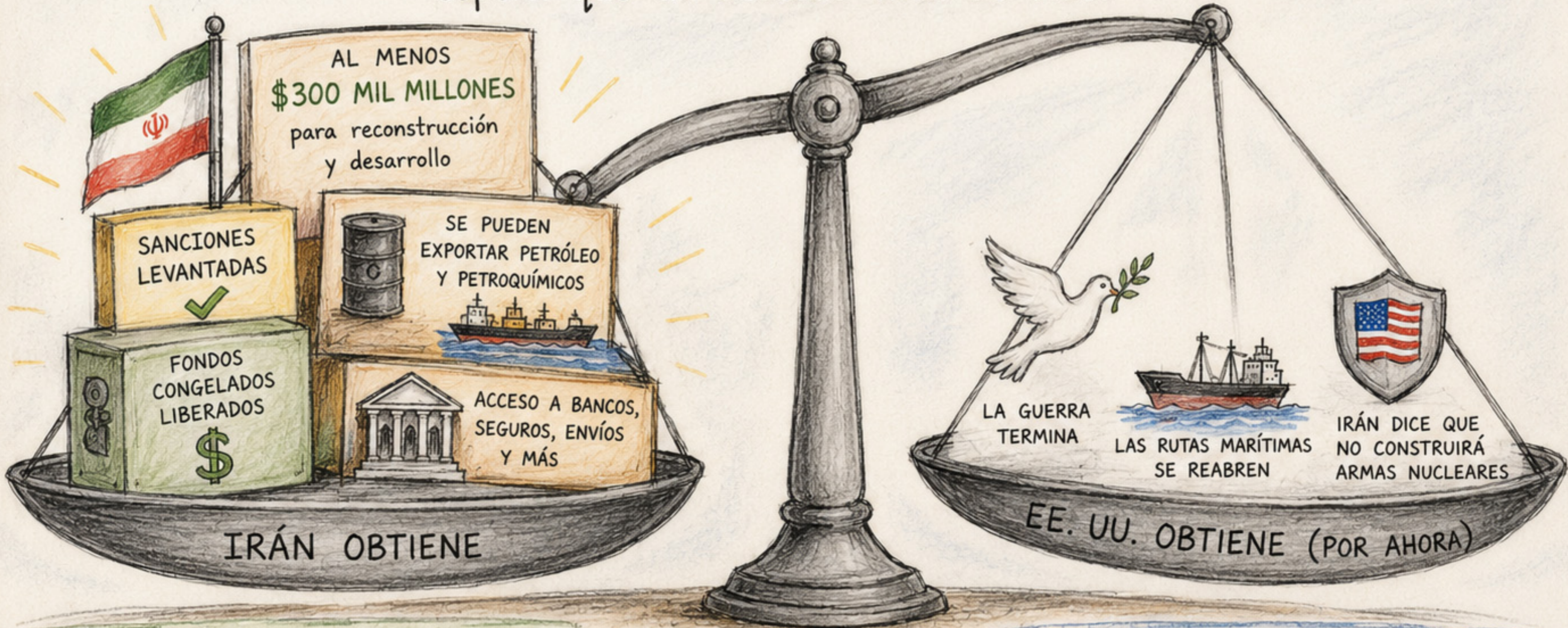

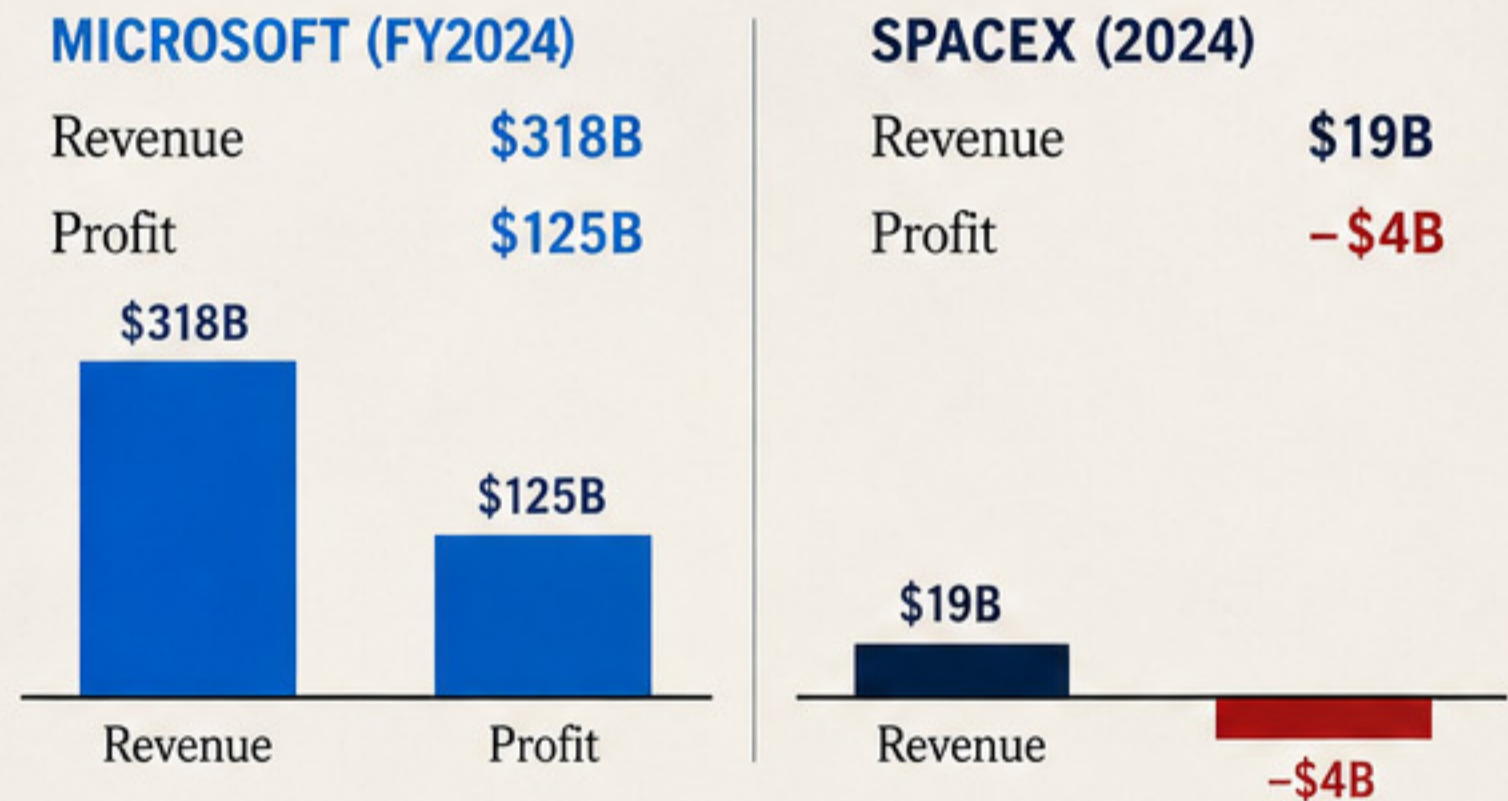

Why is SpaceX valued like Microsoft?

In 2024 Microsoft earned \$125 billion in profits on \$318 billion in revenue. SpaceX lost \$4 billion on \$19 billion in revenue.



Robin Wigglesworth, editor of the *Financial Times* blog *Alphaville*, memorably described Elon Musk's company as a

“very successful but fairly small satellite launch company, bolted onto a stagnant money-losing social media company [X, formerly Twitter] and a money-incinerating AI company [xAI, operator of the widely despised model Grok], and then sprinkled with a lot of hype about humankind going interplanetary.”



And yet at the end of trading yesterday the stock market placed almost as high a value on SpaceX, which went public last Friday, as it did on Microsoft, and slightly more than it placed on Amazon, which made \$78 billion in profits last year.

MARKET CAPITALIZATION (May 24, 2024)

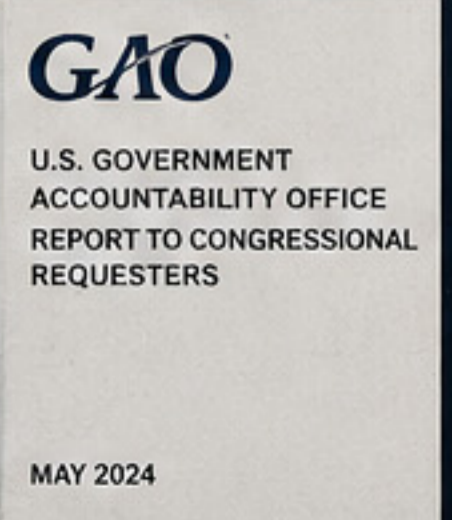

And his current big ideas, like data centers in space, fundamentally don't make sense.

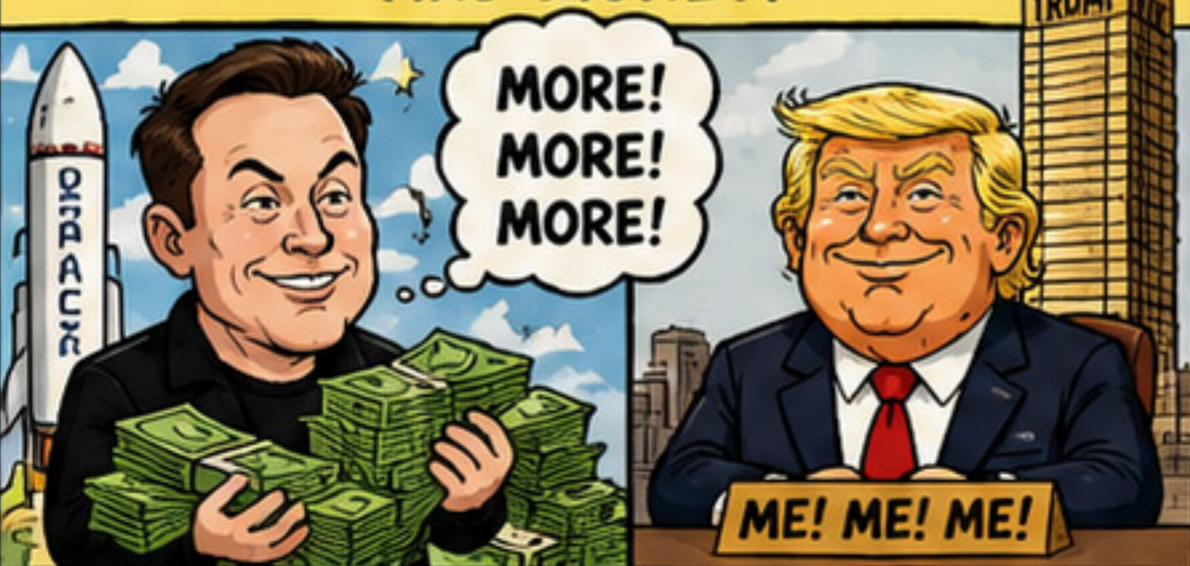

WHAT IRAN SAYS THE DEAL ACTUALLY REQUIRES

Iran had a big press briefing today. Their spokesman, Esmail Baghaei, said the deal means a lot more than what the Trump administration has said. Here's what Iran says:

ISLAMIC REPUBLIC OF IRAN FOREIGN MINISTRY

1. ON SANCTIONS: LIFT THEM ALL, RIGHT AWAY.

Iran says the U.S. must lift all sanctions — secondary, primary, UN Security Council sanctions, and related IAEA board resolutions — the moment the deal (MOU) is signed on Friday.

They say Iran must be able to sell oil and petrochemicals without any problems starting that very day.

2. ON THE STRAIT OF HORMUZ: NOT "TOLLS," JUST FEES.

Baghaei said Iran never wanted to charge "tolls." But he clarified that Iran will charge fees for services like:

- Navigation services
- Environmental protection
- Ship insurance
- Any other services Iran and Oman decide to provide

Those fees will be required for every ship in waters Iran and Oman now say they have authority over.

Fars News reported the draft MOU gives Iran and Oman formal authority over navigation management in the Gulf.

3. ON IRAN'S NUCLEAR MATERIAL: STAY OUT.

Baghaei warned the U.S. directly in response to Trump's comment about wanting to "go in and get it." He reminded Trump's team: They tried entering once, they saw the result, and if they are wise, they will not repeat it.

I'll deal with "nuclear dust later on, when we're ready to go in and do it."

The nuclear material is "harmless."

Meanwhile, JD Vance said: "We've fundamentally changed our relationship with Iran." "We feel that we're at the place now where Iran won't have a nuclear weapon."

4. ON TRUST: IRAN DOESN'T TRUST YOU.

Baghaei was blunt.

- No trust in Israel
- No trust in America
- U.S. decision-making is influenced by extremist and warmongering factions.

Tasnim News Agency (linked to Iran's military) reported that Iran's military headquarters said the Iranian nation "was able to impose their will on coward enemies."

5. VANCE'S "BIG WIN" TALKING POINT

This morning, JD Vance said the real win is that we're "friends with Iran now."

We started a war. We bombed Iran for three months. And now the takeaway is... we have a great relationship?!" It's hard not to **cringe** watching them try to spin this.

It's important to know what each side is really saying. Don't just listen to the spin — look at the facts.
